

PPRIORITY POPULATION

The individual meets DSM-5 diagnostic criteria for a Public Behavioral Health System (PBHS) specialty mental health diagnosis in the Priority Population (either Category A or Category B).

A. Category A Diagnoses **

- Schizophrenia
- Schizophreniform Disorder
- Schizoaffective Disorder, Bipolar Type
- Schizoaffective Disorder, Depressive Type
- Major Depressive Disorder, Recurrent Episode, w/ Psychotic Features
- Bipolar I Disorder, Current or Most Recent Episode Manic, Severe, w/ Psychotic Features.
- Bipolar I Disorder, Current or Most Recent Episode Depressed, Severe, w/ Psychotic Features
- Other Specified Schizophrenia Spectrum and Other Psychotic Disorder
- Unspecified Schizophrenia Spectrum and Other Psychotic Disorder
- Delusional Disorder

** The specific diagnostic criteria may be waived for one of the following two conditions:

1. An individual found not competent to stand trial or not criminally responsible due to a mental disorder pursuant to Criminal

Procedure, § 3-101 et. seq, Annotated Code of Maryland, and receiving services recommended by a Behavioral Health

Administration/Maryland Department of Health evaluator or facility or court order.

2. An individual in a Maryland State psychiatric facility with a length of stay of more than 3 months who requires Residential

Rehabilitation Program (RRP) services upon discharge. This excludes individuals eligible for Developmental Disabilities

Administration Services.

B. Category B Diagnoses

Major Depressive Disorder, Recurrent Episode, Severe

Bipolar I Disorder, Current or Most Recent Episode, Manic, Severe

Bipolar I Disorder Current or Most Recent Episode, Depressed. Severe
