

## PPRIORITY POPULATION

The individual meets DSM-5 diagnostic criteria for a Public Behavioral Health System (PBHS) specialty mental health diagnosis in the Priority Population (either Category A or Category B).

A. Category A Diagnoses \*\*

F20.9=Schizophrenia

F20.81=Schizophreniform Disorder

F25.0=Schizoaffective Disorder, Bipolar Type

F25.1=Schizoaffective Disorder, Depressive Type

F33.3=Major Depressive Disorder, Recurrent Episode, w/ Psychotic Features

**F31.2**=Bipolar I Disorder, Current or Most Recent Episode Manic, Severe, w/ Psychotic Features.

**F31.5**=Bipolar I Disorder, Current or Most Recent Episode Depressed, Severe, w/ Psychotic Features

F28=Other Specified Schizophrenia Spectrum and Other Psychotic Disorder

F29=Unspecified Schizophrenia Spectrum and Other Psychotic Disorder

**F22**=Delusional Disorder

- \*\* The specific diagnostic criteria may be waived for one of the following two conditions:
- 1. An individual found not competent to stand trial or not criminally responsible due to a mental disorder pursuant to Criminal

Procedure, § 3-101 et. seq, Annotated Code of Maryland, and receiving services recommended by a Behavioral Health

Administration/Maryland Department of Health evaluator or facility or court order.

2. An individual in a Maryland State psychiatric facility with a length of stay of more than 3 months who requires Residential

Rehabilitation Program (RRP) services upon discharge. This excludes individuals eligible for Developmental Disabilities

Administration Services.

B. Category B Diagnoses

F33.2=Major Depressive Disorder, Recurrent Episode, Severe

F31.13=Bipolar I Disorder, Current or Most Recent Episode, Manic, Severe

F31.4=Bipolar I Disorder Current or Most Recent Episode, Depressed. Severe

\*Bipolar I Disorder, Current or Most Recent Episode Hypomanic

F31.9=Bipolar I Disorder, Current or Most Recent Episode Hypomanic, Unspecified

\*Bipolar I Disorder, Current or Most Episode Unspecified

F31.81=Bipolar II Disorder

**F60.3**=Borderline Personality Disorder
